

Scholarship Fund

Windom Figure Skating Club Scholarship policy is designed to promote students' ability to learn the sport of figure skating without discrimination on financial status. Scholarships are awarded to students based on financial need, commitment to the Windom Figure Skating Club program and availability.

- Scholarships do NOT cover any portion of registration fees, ice show fees, skate purchase/rental or costume fees. In other words, you will need to be able to cover those fees on your own. If you are unable to do so, we recommend finding an outside sponsor (such as a friend or family member) who will agree to pay those fees.
- Scholarships cover a portion of lesson fees ranging from 25% to 100%. The portion is completely variable, depending on the unique situation. If you are awarded a partial scholarship, you will still be responsible for your reduced tuition rate. Whatever your portion may be, if you are late you will be charged late fees, and will be suspended from the program if the balance is not paid in a timely manner.
- Only one scholarship application is needed per family. The application includes all participating family members.
- We reserve the right to revoke scholarships at any time for any reason. All students must follow our policy handbook and meet eligibility rules below.
- Only students that are in good standing are eligible to receive scholarships. Students/Families that fail to adhere to the conditions of the agreement risk losing their scholarship.
- September 15th applications are due in to the Windom Figure Skating Club email. Any level of class is eligible. Scholarships will be awarded within 2 weeks. If you do not hear from us in that time frame, please contact us. We may also contact you to get additional information.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Students must be between 3 and 18 years of age.
- Students must commit to a 90% attendance to practices.
- Students must agree to work hard and be a good student during practices.
- Student's family must demonstrate financial need.
- Student's family must agree to work (1) additional Ice Show Job
- Student's family must agree to participate in any available fundraiser funds raised will be used to replenish the scholarship fund first before any monies raised will be put into the student's account for costumes, ice show fees, etc.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- Complete the application form in full.
- Sign and adhere to the conditions of the Scholarship Agreement.
